There are numerous **negative and potentially devastating consequences** of problem gambling that often impact the workplace.

SIGNS IN THE WORKPLACE

- **Loss of Time on the Job**
 - Late for work or absent
 - Abuses phone privileges
 - Visits on-line gambling websites
- **Deteriorating Office Behavior**
 - Frequent mood swings
 - Conflicts about unpaid loans
 - Disregard for appearance or hygiene
- **Declining Work Performance**
 - Missed deadlines
 - Diminished work quality
 - Absences from meetings
- **Extreme Gambling Interests**
 - Organizes office pools
 - Plans gambling trips
 - Reads gambling literature
 - Displaying or wearing gambling paraphernalia
- **Desperate Financial Behavior**
 - Defrauds clients or embezzles funds
 - Sells personal or stolen goods at work
 - Uses corporate credit card to gamble
